TERMS AND CONDITIONS APPLY

1. PRIZE

R1 000 (originally R10 000) is awarded to the winner of the RWPHSA Breeders Cup, to introduce the concept. Only locally bred horses can be entered, with their local riders. A minimum age of 3 years is required for the horse.

2 ENTRY CRITERIA

2.1 The Breeder or Stud must be/become a member of RWPHSA, current fee is R500,-.

The Breeders Cup class is available on The RWPHSA Entry Form on www.reiningsa.co.za

- 2.2 Only the points for RWPHSA classes which have been entered and paid for by the horse/rider combinations will count towards the RWPHSA Breeders Cup.
- 2.3 The entry criteria for horse/rider combinations are -
 - must be a paid-up member of an RWPHSA Club
 - horse and rider must be paid-up members of RWPHSA National
- must be a paid-up member of SAEF (day memberships are available for Parys)
 - must have done at least two RWPHSA qualifiers to indicate capabilities
- 2.3 The entries of the horse/rider combinations are a separate process in response to the Show Programme for the SAQHA/AQHA/RWPHSA Convention at Parys in August 2019.

The Breeder will indicate in an email which horse/rider combinations will be entered into the

RWPHSA Breeders Cup, which classes and at which levels, which will be checked against the actual

show entries.

- **2.4** Entries close 12th July 2019, sent to entries.parys2019@gmail.com
- **2.5** A minimum of two and a maximum of five horse/rider combinations are allowed per breeder.
- 2.6 Five RWPHSA classes can be entered, at Novice, Intermediate or Open Level

Reining (4 runs), Ranch Riding (2 runs), Western Pleasure (2 runs), Trail (2 runs), Horsemanship (2 runs)

2.7 The points of the best two horse/rider combinations out of the three best classes, with the points from

two only runs for each class, are accumulated to determine the winner of the RWPHSA Breeders Cup.

3. RWPHSA BREEDERS CUP SELECTION COMMITTEE

The committee selected would be independent persons with the necessary skill, knowledge and insight to advise the breeders of their selections, regulate the number of entries to fit in with the show schedule for Parys 2019, which is being run over <u>5 days</u>, as well as providing a dispute resolution process which will keep everybody happy.

It will probably consist of the existing RWPHSA Board, which will include – President – Jaap Heesterbeek
Treasurer – David Beard
Secretary – Ronel Gillan-Breedt
Show Convenor – Wilma Heesterbeek
Neil Dougall – RWPHSA Judge (and/or International Judge/Judges)

None of the above are breeders, and have any financial or personal interest as to who wins the RWPHSA Breeders Cup.
